INSTRUCTIONS Print on 24 lb. paper. Cut on dots, fold on hyphens. Begin with bottom edge, cutting only enough below the dots so that they remain visible for when you later trim the sides. Then cut just above the top-edge dots in a similar manner. Next, align the hyphens over the sharp edge of your paper cutter and use finger pressure to score the three folds. Finally, trim both sides on the dots. Fold into a triangle, with the fourth panel behind the first. Use two small pieces of double-sided tape to hold it together.
