INSTRUCTIONS Print on 24 lb. paper. Cut on dots, fold on hyphens. **Begin** with bottom edge, cutting only enough below the dots so that they remain visible for when you later trim the sides. **Then** cut just above the top-edge dots in a similar manner. **Next**, align the hyphens over the sharp edge of your paper cutter and use finger pressure to score the three folds. **Finally**, trim both sides on the dots. **Fold** into a triangle, with the fourth panel behind the first. Use two small pieces of double-sided tape to hold it together.
